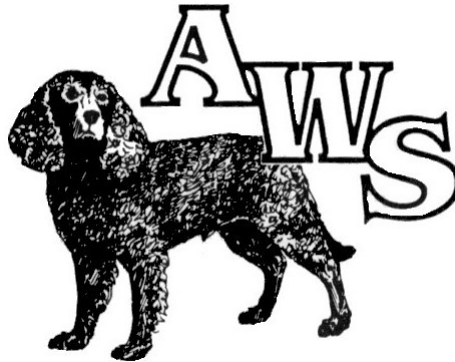

Bred-By-Exhibitor Classes The person handling a dog in the Bred By Exhibitor class must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record. Chapter 3, Section 8 AKC Rules Applying To Dog Shows. (Effective January 1, 2019)

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Non-Regular Classes* . . . Involving Single Dog Entries

VETERANS: Open to dogs and bitches 7 years old or older. Dogs are judged separately from bitches and the winner of each of the Veterans Classes is eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

* **Note** . . . "Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may compete in the Veterans Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competition beyond Best of Breed" . . . *AKC Rules Applying to DOG SHOWS*, Chapter 11, Section 8. Winners of the Veterans Classes may compete for Best of Breed, if otherwise undefeated on the day of the show.

AWARD OF MERIT

At the conclusion of the Best of Breed competition the judge may choose to award up to two of the Best of Breed entries an Award of Merit.



SELECT DOG-SELECT BITCH

After Best of Breed, Best of Winners and Best of Opposite Sex are judged, the remaining Champions of Record will stay in the ring. The judge may award Select Dog and/or Select Bitch from among the Champions of Record. The award of Select Dog or Select Bitch is at the sole discretion of the Judge.

**AKC Grand Championship Ranking System
2010 Oct AKC Board of Directors Minutes**

Without objection the Board approved a new Grand Championship Ranking System, effective immediately. The Grand Champion Ranking system will allow exhibits to continue to accumulate points through the end of the year and the Top 25 winners will be determined and recognized by the largest number of points accumulated by Breed.

In addition, in January 2011 a category for the Top 10 Grand Champion pointed dogs by breed in each state will be available as an added accomplishment to the dog's record. Continuing in May 2011, levels of recognition that include Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum awards of achievement to exhibits obtaining a predetermined number of points for each level of awards will be available. These awards will not be considered a title.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES . . . Involving Multiple Dog Entries

NOTE: *As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch and Brace Class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to complete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.*

STUD DOG - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. The Stud dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, and **MUST** be shown in the ring with the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its breed. Get only to be judged on the merits of the Get. Each dog making up the Get must be individually entered in one of the Regular Classes or Best of Breed Competition.

BROOD BITCH - Same as Stud Dog Class, except replace "Stud Dog" with "Brood Bitch" and "Get" with "Produce."

**Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."*

BRACE CLASS - (Each Brace shall be composed of two American Water Spaniels owned by identical owners). The dogs comprising the Brace must be named at time of entry. In making entries for "Brace Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms and a regular entry fee must be paid for the individual dog as well as the fee for the unit. An entry form for a dog entered in a regular class or veteran class or Best of Breed Competition and entered as part of a brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes, "Brace Class." If more than one brace is entered by same owner, the dogs comprising each brace must so designated – "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc.

Be sure all information is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Novice. This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open. This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open Class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

Master. This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

SWEEPSTAKES

The Sweepstakes are open to all American Water Spaniels who are 6 to 18 months of age and who are also entered in the Regular Classes.

SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATIONS

- Puppy Dog 6 months & under 9 monthsPuppy Bitch
- Puppy Dog 9 months & under 12 months Puppy Bitch
- Junior Dog12 months & under 18 monthsJunior Bitch

All entries in the Sweepstakes must be entered in a Regular Class and entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as for the Regular Classes. Entries in Sweepstakes shall be indicated on the entry form in the space marked, "Additional Classes" by the use of the word "Sweepstakes" and the Class Division and indicate the dog's age group—6-9 mo, 9-12 mo, 12-18 mo.

SWEEPSTAKES PRIZES

The American Water Spaniel Club, Inc. will retain 35% of the entry fees for expenses. The remaining monies constituting the balance of the entry fees for that class* will be divided as follows:

- First40%
- Second30%
- Third10%
- Fourth20%

*Note: Prize moneys will be rounded to the nearest 25¢
Cash prizes are given in the ring to the party showing the dog.
All dogs must be entered in a regular class to qualify.

4-6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY (SPECIAL EVENT)

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows at the option of the show giving club.

AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.

All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.

Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.*

The **Certificate of Merit (CM)** title is an introductory title to AKC conformation events.

Entrants in each breed shall compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed. Winners of the Best of Breed in each of the individual breeds or varieties will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the number of dogs defeated in their breed or variety. Winners of Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed in each of the individual breeds or varieties will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the number of dogs defeated in their sex. The Certificate of Merit requires 15 points awarded in accordance with the following points structure.

UNSIGNIED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable with entry confirmation notice and judging program. Should such acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Dog Shows By Design's Office.

MAKE ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO . . . Cindy O'Hare, Dog Shows By Design. CANADIAN EXHIBITORS must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Tabulate carefully.

POST DATED CHECKS, AND RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check or declined card.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH OR CONFINED TO THEIR CRATES except when being judged.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that Show is over, and the Secretary advised at once. The Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

ALL TROPHIES must be claimed at the show . . . If not, they become the property of the Show Giving Club. NO TROPHIES will be mailed.

AMERICAN WATER SPANIEL CLUB, INC., RESERVES THE RIGHT to substitute trophies with ones of equal or greater value.
